- 2. An endorsement naming Hydrite Chemical Co. as an additional insured in the connection with the performance of the work by any contractor.
- 3. Limits of liability that meet or exceed the coverage and limits on the enclosed requirements for Certificates of Insurance.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS RAILROAD CONTRACTORS AND SUBCONTRACTORS:

All railroad contractors and subcontractors will be required to carry railroad protective liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$1,000,000. Payment and performance bonds are required for all contracts of \$50,000 or more.

Contractors and subcontractor shall submit with the bid a certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total price of the bid payable unconditionally to the owner. When submitting a bid bond, it shall contain a Power of Attorney for the full amount of the bid bond from a surety company authorized to do business in the State of and acceptable to Hydrite. The check or bond of the unsuccessful bidder(s) shall be returned. The check or bond of the Bidder to whom the contract is awarded shall be retained until a contract is executed and the required performance bond or other security is submitted. The check or bond of the successful Bidder shall be forfeited if the bidder fails to enter into a contract. Failure to submit a bid guarantee shall result in rejection of the bid.
