

#### **Fertilizer Product Expansion Program (FPEP)**

Hydrite has recently been awarded a \$3.95 million grant for expansion projects at our Waterloo, IA and Terre Haute, IN facilities. The grant from the U.S. Department of Agriculture will support energy efficiency throughout our fertilizer production operations. So far, the funding has supported the construction of an on-site electricity generation system at our Terre Haute facility that we expect to be operational by 2026.

## **OUR CUSTOMERS**

Hydrite's food team continues to deliver savings to our customers through our technical expertise and opportunistic spirit resulting in time, energy, and water savings complete with safety improvements and production increases.



#### Energy Savings & Beyond with Hydrite Technology Solution



We are continuously seeking opportunities to collaborate with our customers to achieve their operational and sustainability goals by increase process efficiency and reducing costs, and our groundbreaking Soil Load Mapping (SLM) technology was instrumental in accomplishing these efforts in 2024.

The SLM technology optimizes clean-in-place processes to effectively remove soils and optimize wash temperatures. This allows our customer partners to reduce processing times, energy usage, and water consumption. A deployment of this technology at our customer is projected to save 3,000,000 therms of natural gas annually, reducing greenhouse gas emissions by 16,000 metric tons and delivering over \$1 million in yearly energy savings once fully rolled out.
